**Sunday, August 28<sup>th</sup>** we will be welcoming the Reverend Doctor Dennis K Kitterman. Rev. Dr. Kitterman hails from Indianapolis, Indiana where he attended Northminster Presbyterian Church in his youth. He graduated from Princeton Theological Seminary in 1982 and was ordained in 1983. After three years as the Associate Pastor in Erie PA, he was called to active duty by the USAF. His assignments included, Lackland AFB San Antonio TX, Howard AFB Republic of Panama, Bergstrom AFB Austin TX, Tyndall AFB Panama City FL, Barksdale AFB Shreveport LA, Rhein Main AB, Frankfurt Germany, Hansom AFB Boston MA and deployments to include Kuwait and Saudi Arabia. While in the Air Force Dennis received a Dr. of Min from Austin Theological Seminary in Austin Texas. In 2009 he retired from active duty and moved to Tarpon Springs, Florida. He is married to Cecilia Kitterman and they have three sons: Chris, a pediatrician in St Petersburg, Dan, a branch manager for Enterprise in Pompano Beach, and Andrew who is studying to be a Physician's Assistant in Savannah.
