Norm became involved in ministering to needs of the homeless as interim Co-Executive Director with Halifax Urban Ministries in Daytona Beach in 2003. He also served as pulpit supply for Southminster Presbyterian Church, Daytona Beach.

Since being called to the Tampa area in 2005, Norm has served Church of the Reconciler, Clearwater; St. Andrews Presbyterian Church, Dunedin; the Presbytery of Tampa Bay and the Synod of the South Atlantic. His assignments have included Stated Supply, Parish Associate, Chair of the Presbytery Personnel Committee, Stated Clerk of the Presbytery and Clerk of the Synod Permanent Judicial Commission.

Phyllis and Norm are golfers who also enjoy reading, travel, and meeting new people. Meanwhile, as a now honorably retired minister, the primary objective of his spiritual journey is to continually seek God’s will in his life and to share God’s word with others.
