**Welcome** worship guests! You are special because God brought you into our presence. Together, we rejoice and celebrate God's blessings in our lives.

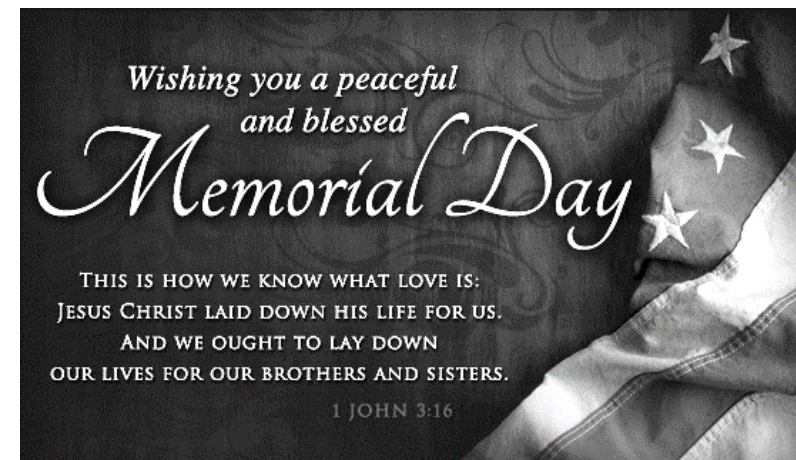
**The chancel flowers** are from The Haslam Family to the Glory of God and in honor of Melanie's birthday.

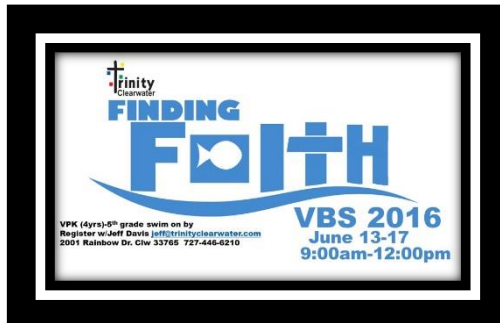
## Children, Youth, and Family Summer Ministry
