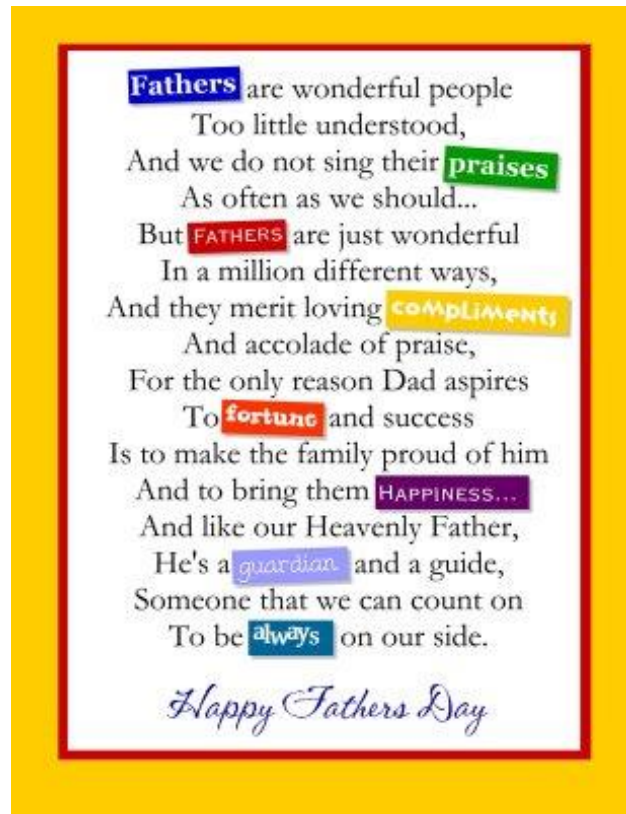
**Harbor Light:** The deadline for the July/August Harbor Light is Wednesday, June 22<sup>nd</sup>.
