### **Pastor Nominating Committee Candidates**

We hope to form a Pastor Nominating Committee (PNC) for PCPH next month. In parallel with the completion of the Mission Study that must be reviewed by the Council of Ministries of the Presbytery of Tampa Bay prior to forming the PNC, we are preparing for the formation of the committee.
