Children

Sunday School: Each week our elementary age children have the privilege of participating in Sunday School which takes place during the same time as worship. *Immediately following the Children's Message, children between the ages of 4 and 11 leave the Sanctuary with our Sunday School Teachers to continue with their age-appropriate curriculum.* Our hope is that children will learn God's Word and have a strong Christian foundation for their future as they grow up in His Word.

Nursery (Birth - Age 3) "Frolic": A curriculum created for babies and toddlers that was developed by early childhood experts, Frolic resources introduce little ones to faith concepts in age-appropriate ways. Our hope at PCPH is to equip all families with children of any age with the right materials to start their faith journey at a young age.

Little Ones (Age 4 – 6) SparkHouse Lectionary Curriculum: Kids and leaders gather to explore their Bibles, enjoy fun activities, pray, and grow in faith. The curriculum follows the church lectionary in a fun and exciting way to create a faith that is grounded in truth. *Little ones may be picked up after worship in the Old Narthex.*

Older Ones (Age 7 - 11) "Connect": Connect takes children on a journey through the Old Testament and into the New Testament exploring the connections between several stories each week. The curriculum includes a video, lesson, and hands on projects. Older ones may be picked up after worship in Fellowship Hall.

Easter Egg Hunt: PCPH will once again host our annual Easter Egg Hunt on Saturday April 1st from 10:00am - 12:00pm. The event will be filled with fun, fellowship, games, and much more. The egg hunt is for children of all ages, and their families. PCPH will have a Kona Ice truck on site, a bounce house, crafts, games, activities, and much more. Be sure to bring your own Easter egg basket, and to arrive not later than 10:00am as our Egg Hunt will begin promptly at 10:00am. **As in years past, we also need some adults to arrive early to hide eggs. Season of Lent



The season of Lent is a time of prayer, penitence, and self-examination in preparation for the celebration of the resurrection of the Lord at Easter. It lasts 40 days, like Jesus' time of testing in the wilderness. (The Sundays in Lent are not counted in this period between Ash Wednesday and Easter, as

every Lord's Day is a celebration of the resurrection of Jesus Christ.) In the early church, Lent was a time of preparation for the celebration of baptism on Easter. In many communities of faith it remains a time to equip and nurture candidates for baptism and confirmation. Lent reminds us of Whose we are; it's a time to clear our heads and humbly focus not on the demands of our lives, but on our God who offers us courage, comfort, and meaning in our lives. It's a time to be centered in God's unconditional love for us.
