### PCPH PROPERTY DRIVE

In 2001 PCPH built a new sanctuary. Now 17 years later we are facing the inevitable job of updating and property maintenance.

- Replace the double doors on the electric panel room. **\$2100 - DONE**
- Enclosing of our two retention ponds, using chain link. **\$6500 (Mid-July)**
- Complete clean up of the northwest side of the parking lot. **\$9000 (next 3 months)**
- The final two air conditioning units for the sanctuary. **\$ 26,000**
- Replace the Sanctuary roof. This is a near future project, 2/3 years, to replace the roof **\$62,000 (estimated)**
