

PCPH PROPERTY DRIVE

In 2001 PCPH built a new sanctuary. Now 17 years later we are facing the inevitable job of updating and property maintenance.

- Replace the double doors on the electric panel room. **\$2100**
- Enclosing of our two retention ponds, using chain link. **\$6500**
- Complete clean up of the northwest side of the parking lot. **\$9000**
- The final two air conditioning units for the sanctuary. **\$ waiting for bids**
- Replace the Sanctuary roof. This is a near future project, 2/3 years, to replace the roof **\$62,000 (estimated)**

There are 2 ways to give:

Session Summary (meeting of June 11, 2018):

- Temporary funding was approved to execute needed repairs and maintenance until funds are raised through the 2018 Property Drive that is ongoing.
- The negative cash flow situation for this year was discussed. Efforts are underway to work on this situation.
- Use of Fellowship Hall on October 27 for the Tag Sale to raise operating funds for PCPH was approved.
- The following policies for PCPH were approved:
 - Child Protection Policy
 - Sexual Misconduct/Harassment Policy
 - Response Coordination Procedure (for handling misconduct under policies)
 - Elder Cycle Renewal Policy (revising the timing for elder and Nominating Committee terms to start in June rather than January to improve transitions and to fit better with the budget cycle.)
- Lori Smith was selected as Treasurer for PCPH starting in January, 2019.
- Several Ministry assignments of elders were approved effective July 1:
 - Lori Smith will move from Children, Youth, & Family to Operations
 - Rick Bacon will move from Operations to Worship
 - Kristin Simunac will move from Worship to Clerk of Session
 - Tom Krisa will move from Clerk of Session to Children, Youth, & Family
- Carol Heath and Lori Smith were appointed to be the Session members on the Nominating Committee for the next year.
