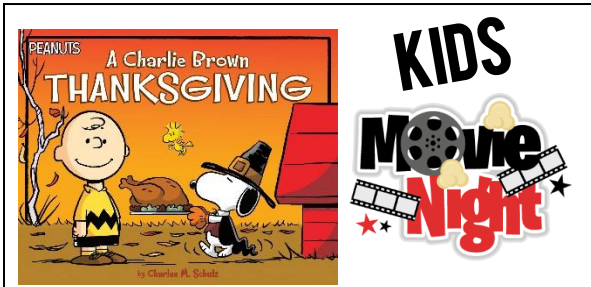
**November 18 (Sunday) after the service (HELPERS NEEDED)**
